For the purpose of traceability of possible infection paths to the responsible authorities we are collecting and storing the following data from you:

- Name and surname
- Address
- · Date and duration of visit
- If available: telephone number or E-mail

The legal basis for this is Article 6(1)(c) of the Basic Data Protection Regulation (DS-GVO) in conjunction with § Article 6 para. 1 CoronaVO (Ordinance of the State Government on infection-protective measures against the spread of the SARS-CoV-2 virus) of 23 June 2020. In the event of a concrete suspicion of infection, the competent authorities are the recipients of this data in accordance with the Federal Infection Protection Act (§ 6 Para. 3 CoronaVO). After receipt we will keep your personal data for **four weeks.** After expiration of this period the data will be deleted (§ 6 Abs. 2 CoronaVO).

You are not obligated to provide your personal data; also the operator will not control them for correctness. However, if you do not provide us with your personal data, you may not visit our premises (§ 6 para. 4 CoronaVO).

## Reference to data subject's rights:

Under the DS-GVO, you have the following rights: information on the personal data we process about you; correction if the data is incorrect or restriction of our processing; deletion if we are no longer obliged to store the data. If you are of the opinion that we are not duly processing your data, you also have the right to complain to the State Commissioner for Data Protection and Freedom of Information of Baden-Württemberg, Königstrasse 10a, 70173 Stuttgart.
